

Metro Communications Committee
November 8, 2018
Minutes

Commissioner Gary Claridy called the meeting to order.

Committee members in attendance were Claridy, Dwight Jewell, Seth Thurman, Amber Russell, Amy Thomas, Landon Gulley & Beverly Atwood. Others in attendance included Mayor Stephen Chambers & Sheriff Ray Russell.

Claridy as acting chair called for election of Chairman, Vice Chairman and Secretary.

Jewell nominated Russell for Chair. With no other nominations, Jewell made a motion for nominations to cease and elect Russell by acclamation. Gulley seconded. So moved.

Gulley nominated Claridy as Vice Chair. With no other nominations, Russell motioned that nominations cease and elect Claridy by acclamation. Gulley seconded. So moved.

Gulley nominated Thurman as Secretary. With no other nominations, Gulley motioned that nominations cease and elect Thurman by acclamation. Atwood seconded. So moved.

Jewell motioned that the county move forward with putting the county email on the Gmail platform. A second was made by Thomas. So moved. Moving forward there will be training with commissioners and county personnel to provide greater use of the product.

Mayor Chambers is in the process of updating the look and feel of the county website. He is getting bids and will have more information the next time the committee meets. The goal is to have something before budgeting starts in March.

Moving forward we hope to have updates from Tammy Dixon, committee member and Tri-County Electric employee, on updates to the broadband installation across the county.

With no other business, the meeting was adjourned with a motion from Jewell, second by Gulley. Seeing no objection, the committee stood adjourned.
